Narrandera Shire Council appreciates Wagga Wagga Council Mayor Cr Conkey's support in recognising the need to retain services in smaller regional towns.

We understand the reasons behind moving the electoral office to Wagga but the loss of three jobs in Narrandera is disappointing and we need to continue to fight to retain services in our town.

The recent announcements that the motor registry will become a service centre and that our TAFE is to become a Connected Learning Centre are very encouraging.

Funding has also been announced from the fixing country truck wash fund to build a truck wash in Narrandera.
