## MORE RSA OPPORTUNITIES

Narrandera Shire Council is again offering young adults in the community the opportunity to receive Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) training at a discounted price. The course will cost \$80, half of the normal course fee of \$160.

“Following a successful course last year, when 15 participants completed their qualification, we are pleased to be able to offer another course on the evening of Wednesday 13 March,” said Elizabeth Mudford, Narrandera Shire Councils Road Safety Officer.

“This opportunity allows young people the chance to gain their RSA Certificate when they might not have been able to otherwise. Completion of the course can open up employment opportunities and in addition participants will learn about the dangers and consequences of drink driving.”

The aim of the RSA training is to educate young adults about:

- the legislation relating to the responsible service of alcohol in NSW
- the impact of alcohol abuse on families, communities and tax payers
- preventing intoxication, underage drinking and drink driving

The course is available to residents of Narrandera Shire aged between 17 and 25 years. Young people aged between 17-18 years old are able to complete the course and receive their certificates but are not able to be employed in licenced premises until they are 18 years of age.

The course will be delivered by Western Riverina Community College commencing at 4:30pm and finishing at 11pm at the Emergency Operations Centre, 17-21 Twynam Street, Narrandera.
