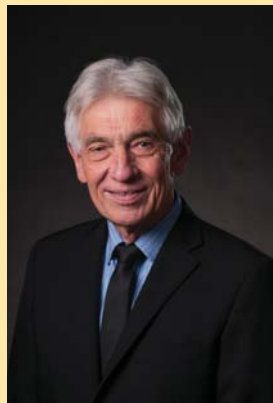

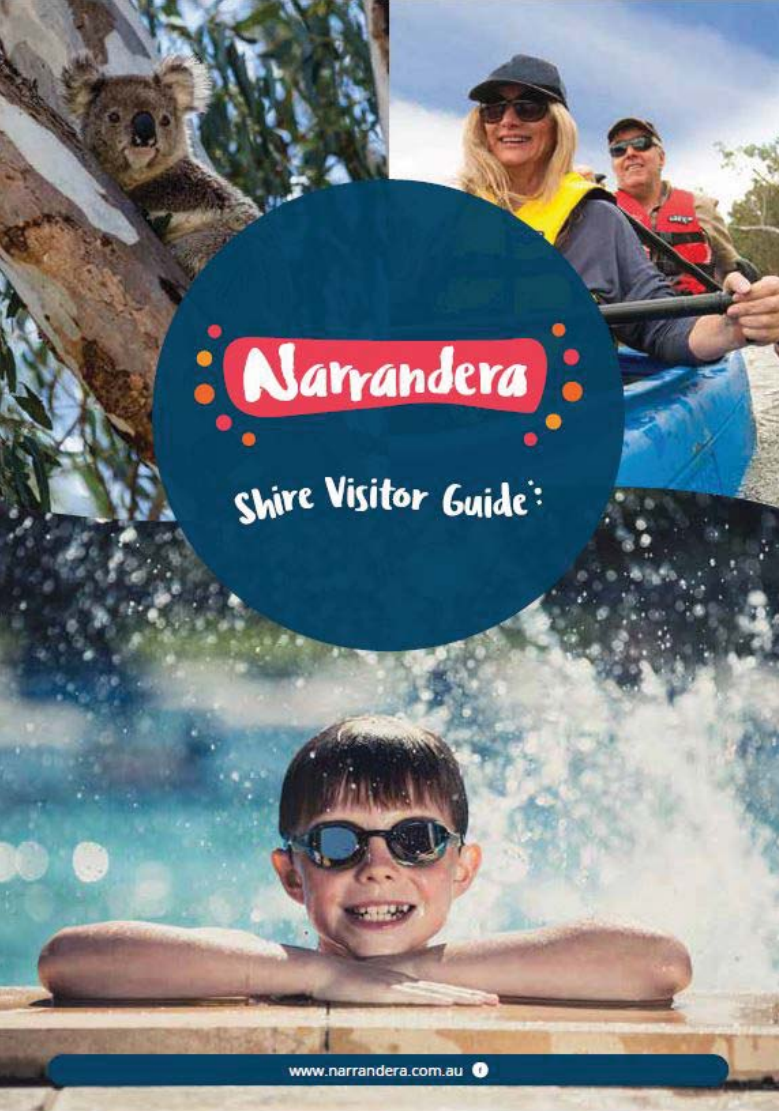

Toilet Cleaning	Daily	<p>Flood restoration works: Council is working together with earthmoving contractors in various flood restoration works. Marking of restoration location and gravel carting has been progressing in the southern section of the Shire. Earthworks has begun on Devlins Bridge Road. The work sequence of upcoming restoration works are: <i>Mundara Road, Mollys Lagoon Road, Bassett Road, Windella Road, Mellors Road, Jolleys Road, Kangaroo Plain road. Flood restoration work will continue on throughout the year.</i></p> <p>Roadworks: Council's roadwork construction crew will continue work on laneways in Narrandera including <i>Dundas Lane, Willam Street Lane and Roslyn Street Lane (South West Dalgetty Street)</i>. After completion of these laneway works, the construction crew will continue or rural resheeting works on the following roads in sequence: <i>Bulloak Tank Road, Bandys Road, Geddes Road, Euratha Road, Hulmes Road and Old Wagga Road.</i></p> <p>Miscellaneous works: The Urban construction team is continuing on installation of the causeway at <i>Barellan Sandy Creek Road</i>. After completing this causeway over the next 3 weeks, the crew will then be mobilised to Cowabbie Creek causeway installation at <i>Pamandi Road</i>.</p>

After Easter, the maintenance grading crew will recommence maintenance grading works on unsealed local roads of Narrandera Shire Council.</p>	
		<p>RMS works: The deteriorated pavement of <i>Newell Highway from Gillenbah to Canal Bridge</i> is going to be upgraded as Asphalt Pavement. Up to 450mm of depth of pavement will be removed and asphalt will be laid over it. The project is scheduled to commence by early May 2018.</p>
