

I am writing to you to in support of the Skywalk over Lake Talbot project proposed for Narrandera Shire Council.

Not much has changed since the decision was made at The Ordinary Meeting of Narrandera Shire Council in October 2021 and as the mover of the resolution, I stand by my comments on the day.

There are still land claim issues, residents near the proposed development would lose their privacy and right to a peaceful lifestyle, who has tenure over the bridge, the grant timelines, and no public access to the bridge are all solid reasons for not going ahead with the lattice bridge project. Only 50 people out of a population of over 4000 are speaking out, hardly the majority.

The notion to return the funds is ludicrous and in my belief would jepordise future funding opportunities for Narrandera Shire Council.

The skywalk project fits the grant guidelines and would be a welcome addition/attraction to the Shire.

#### Dear George

I would like to register my support for the proposed Lake Talbot Skywalk project.

I believe that an additional structure adjacent to the Lake Talbot Pool Complex (complete with slides and associated structures), Lake Talbot Tourist Park, boat ramp, amenity block, etc fits logically into a developed area around a man-made lake. The construction location fits into an already disturbed area with an abundance of man-made attractions and can only improve the proposed construction site.

I believe the opposition by some community members to the Skywalk project on environmental grounds is seriously flawed, particularly if they are also still asserting that the rail bridge was a better project for environmental reasons.

- The lake is man-made, the surrounds are already extensively developed, there are already many
  visitors and vehicles to the area, and additional visitor numbers will make little difference to the
  environment.
- Conversely, the rail bridge sits quietly away from significant vehicle and foot traffic in a natural
  environment which is a favourable circumstance for the native flora and fauna. Had that project gone
  ahead, there would have been considerable changes including constructed ramp and parking, plus the
  disturbance to a natural and peaceful area by the addition of people, their vehicles, noise, litter, etc.

I believe the opposition by some community members to the Skywalk project on aesthetics is seriously flawed.

- The concept drawing of the proposed Skywalk has been identified as 'concept'. There has been no announcement of which I am aware stating that it is the design of the final structure. I would expect that, if approved, the design would be developed to be sympathetic and complementary to the environment and surrounds.
- I have visited skywalks/viewing platforms throughout Australia, New Zealand and Europe. The one
  characteristic linking them all is that the design is immaterial, the focus is the view. Many are
  unobtrusive and frankly unremarkable because it is not about the structure, they have been designed
  to showcase the view.
- What is pleasant to the eye for one person may not be to everyone's liking, however feedback on aesthetics should wait until a detailed design is available. There was considerable opposition regarding the design of the Sydney Opera House and the London Eye prior to final approval; both are now acknowledged as icons of their respective cities and are significant tourist attractions. As Taylor Swift sang, "haters gonna hate" and there does seem to be a minority who are intent on opposing the project in any form.

• There seems to be small group that has not appreciated the difficulties achieving the proposed rail bridge project (eg: ownership, access, lack of or onerous approvals from State Heritage and TfNSW, lack of agreement from other key stakeholders, etc). The rail bridge is beautiful in its simplicity, however the potential addition of ugly security fencing, mid-way barrier, signage, and metres and metres of concrete ramp, etc would render it very ugly in my opinion.

I attended a public meeting on 29 March, its purpose promoted on facebook as being to save the lake from the Skywalk. It has been disingenuous for organisers to say the meeting was unanimously against the Skywalk.

- The meeting was promoted clearly to people who did not want the Skywalk and many supporters of the project did not feel there would be any point attending.
- Although there was an informal call during the meeting for people to vote against the Skywalk proposal, there was no corresponding opportunity for those of us in favour of the project to respond.
- The meeting attracted approximately 50-60 people. I felt that there were possibly four-five people younger than me, with probably 85% of those in attendance aged 60-90. Those attending the meeting may have been predominantly against the Skywalk project, but it was a very narrow cross-section and not representative of the broader community.
- In the past week there have been two posts on a Narrandera community facebook page, including a poll, which garnered much community feedback. Before mysteriously disappearing, the poll was returning approximately 136 in favour of the Skywalk to 90 against. Posts included feedback from a diverse sample of the community with a wide spread of ages and interests.

Some community members have suggested the funding be returned to the government. This is seriously flawed.

- The funding is tourism related. Any increase in visitor numbers and preferably overnight stays has the potential to increase expenditure in Narrandera, benefiting both business owners, their employees, and the wider community as a result.
- Returning funding has the potential to flag to governments, and the bureaucrats making allocation
  decisions, that Narrandera Shire does not want or need injections of grant money. A great many
  projects in councils across NSW are dependent on grant funding via a competitive process. I cannot see
  any benefit in making it harder to achieve this vital form of resourcing.

Some community members against the Skywalk project have indicated that my opinion does not count as I work for Council. This is seriously flawed given my connection to Narrandera Shire is much more than my current employment.

- My great-grandfather came to Brewarrena Station with Jeremiah Rogers in 1861 and over the next 160
  years my family has continued to farm at Sandigo.
- I have lived in Narrandera Shire my entire life; at Sandigo, Grong Grong, and at various Narrandera addresses as a ratepayer. I have chosen to remain in Narrandera to raise my family in the home we built here.
- Eighty percent of my life has been spent not working at Council. My work history has been with three major employers based in Narrandera Shire.
- My role at Council has had no input or involvement with the skywalk project to date.

I wish to lodge my objection to this proposal. It would be a blot on the landscape and I doubt it would bring the number of tourists to this town to justify the huge cost involved. Yes, the grey nomads who stop for morning tea at our beautiful Marie Bashir park may duck over to have a look but it's not going to encourage them to stay over night or to make it into the main shopping precinct. It is definitely the grey nomads who pass through our beautiful town. School holidays during the cooler months, yes, we get families as well. Not so much during the hot months. I have a couple of suggestions which could be built onto as we gain further grants.

- 1. Cycle paths to be extended along our section of the river. The cycle path at Tumbarumba is one example. When we stayed at caravan park not long after it first opened there were three different caravan clubs staying during that week. You couldn't move down the main street. All cafes full and parking was at a minimum. If we could turn the cycle paths into one where competitions could be held this would appeal to all ages. Admittedly there would need to be considerable earth works to make one of the tracks up to competition standard.
- 2. Walking tracks along the river could be expanded. Example being the river walk at Hay which includes benches with river views and barbques, There is access at various points for vehicles to park. Along the way there are information stations and some great metal artwork.
- 3. Street art. We have such a rich history, not just indigenous, which we don't appear to promote. Our chinese and agricultural history would make amazing scenes for street art. We have many buildings on corners just crying out for this type of art.

Thanks for your email. I was unsure of the skywalk when it was first proposed but after having visited the site, I think it will be a wonderful addition to the area.

As you know it is grant money and we have already applied for a change in the project and if we apply again to change the scope it won't be successful and if we don't complete a project with this grant money that is similar and of the same value as the original project, we will have to send that money back. This will certainly not do us any favours in future grant applications. A walking track along that area would be wonderful but again that has some teething issues, one being that the land is crown land and so far, we have not been successful to obtain permission to do works of any kind along the walking track and there is also sacred land along the way that will need to be preserved. Until these things are in order, we can't build a walking track. I walk along the current track often and although it is a bit rough in some areas it is still accessible and a beautiful walk especially in the early hours of the morning. It takes me around an hour and a half to walk that loop around the lake. I stop to take a lot of photos especially if the waterfall is running.

I know your disappointment in the bridge project and your feelings are valid, but that project was never going to fair well with the RTA not agreeing, the heritage people not agreeing and the fact that the area is very sacred to the Aboriginal people who were in fact against the project.

I would have loved to see a walkway over the bridge and back into town if it were in another location and not next door to Koori beach.

I am sure that the viewing platform will be well received by visitors and locals in the future. I have heard quite a lot of positive statements about it especially from the younger members of the community. My own son in law is an engineer and senior project manager of a world-wide company and when I showed him the plans, he was very impressed with the design and thought that it would sit well in the area.

While I understand that this project is funded by government grant money and is being built for the purpose of attracting and enticing tourists to our town I am strongly against this project for the following reasons.

- 1. I personally don't think that this project is a great 'Bang for Buck' project and from what I have seen and read it is merely just a viewing platform, surely if we want to get a great view of our beautiful lake that money could be better spent on existing viewing areas i.e., the lookout at the top of the boat ramp hill.
- 2. What access is there going to be to the "Skywalk" itself? Are there going to be steps down to it? Is everyone going to be able to access it based on the demographic of tourists that stay at the Lake Talbot Caravan Park (I feel that this demographic of tourists would be more likely to use it than anyone else).
- 3. As I have said previously, I do not think that this will bring more tourists into town rather give those tourists that have already made their way here for various other reasons something extra to look at, is this worth the \$820,000+ that has been allocated to this project? I personally don't think so.
- 4. As a local resident and business owner I would like to see those funds go into a more worthwhile project like re-establishing a better walking track between the lake and the rocky water holes that is accessible for everyone, I think this would be a better utilisation of the funds that have been given.

I was born and breed here and I have seen a lot of people come and go with some good ideas and some not so good ideas, unfortunately some of the not so good ideas we ae now stuck with! As a community we must work collectively and cohesively to ensure that we do what is best for our town and our whole community and if an agreement cannot be reached maybe the Council should give the grant back to the government because at the end of the day us as taxpayers are funding that grant.

I hope you will take my thoughts into consideration before making a decision on whether to proceed with this proposal or not.

I am writing to you to express my concerns in regards to the planned skywalk at Lake Talbot. In my opinion the skywalk would have a negative impact on the natural beauty of this area.

I am a frequent visitor of the pool complex and the view from the pool across the lake and the common is beautiful. I often meet out of town visitors at the pool and they always express how impressed they are with the beautiful surroundings, there are virtually no other buildings to be seen (apart from the old pump shed) just nature.

With over 80% of Australia's population living in urban areas I believe that tourists coming to our regional areas are not interested in new manmade structures of which they have plenty in the city, but would rather be in a natural environment or visit places with historic significance.

My first preference would be to use the existing funding for the lattice railway bridge project as this is a historic monument that could be a real drawcard to the area and would work in well with the existing bike tracks in the wetlands and the Common.

It was very disappointing to hear at last week's public meeting that the Councillors (in caretaker mode!) took it upon themselves to reject the proposal, especially without involving or informing the local Landcare group who spent countless hours working on the proposal. It is thanks to the local Landcare group that we have the Wetlands and the Rocky Water Hole Bridge, their track record speaks for themselves and they certainly deserve to be informed and consulted.

If the grant money can't be transferred back to Railway Bridge project, I would suggest to use the money to improve the walking tracks around Lake Talbot and make them more accessible for tourists and locals. The walking track that starts near the boat ramp and goes all the way to the Rocky Water Hole has beautiful views over the lake. It is however very narrow and in parts unsafe. It is not signposted and therefore mainly only known to locals. An improvement to this track would enable visitors to do a Loop around the lake, coming back on the track along the channel (adjacent to Common). That existing track along the channel could also be improved and be made wheelchair friendly to give even more people the chance to explore that area and spot some koalas on the way.

## <u>Subject: Submission supporting reinstatement of Lattice Bridge Project in lieu of proposed</u> <u>Skywalk Project</u>

Narrandera Landcare Inc wish to respond to the call for public submissions associated with the proposed Skywalk project and also the recent public meeting associated with the proposal.

In summary Narrandera Landcare Inc ask that Council review its position in regard to the Skywalk proposal and reinstate the funding allocation to the Lattice Rail Bridge Project under the" Playground on the Murrumbidgee" Grant funding arrangement.

The following circumstances support this review;

- a. Much work has been undertaken to bring the Lattice Bridge Project to fruition. In the last six years detailed negotiation with key agencies have been in progress culminating in the preparation of an Integrated Development Application. Notwithstanding that Council did not approve the Railway Bridge Application, the template for a Development Approval process has been established.
- b. The project was originally approved and allocated funds under the "Playground on the Murrumbidgee" package and supported by Narrandera Shire Council.
- c. The recent public meeting to gauge the community support for the Skywalk reflected strong support for the Railway River Bridge project over the current Skywalk proposal.

Narrandera Landcare are confident that with the strong community support and a definite commitment of Council that the Railway Lattice Bridge can be successfully reinstated and achieved.

The outstanding agency issues are summarised below;

### **Heritage Council of NSW**

Approval under Section 60 of the Heritage Act 1977 is required for the project to proceed. An application under this section had been made by John Holland Rail and involved the removal of rail line and sleepers from the bridge. The Application was refused on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2021. A number of variations were proposed that would identify the bridge as a railway bridge but did not appear acceptable to the Heritage officers involved.

A favourable response has already been received from Heritage NSW as General Terms of Approval Integrated Development Application subject to submission to an application under Section 60 by Council.

It is proposed that an application under Section 60 of the Heritage Act 1977 be prepared by Council based on retaining the rail line on the bridge but removal of sleepers which would address safety issues for the future.

It is considered that with strong support by Council and representations to the Minister if necessary, that this compromise involving removal of the old sleepers can be achieved with Heritage Council of NSW

## Transport for NSW/John Holland-now replaced by UGL

Two outstanding matters relating to Transport for NSW are summarised below;

## 1. Licence for use of Bridge

Agreement in principle was received from Transport for NSW however one condition required Council to be responsible for maintenance of the whole bridge. In earlier discussions it was advised that Council would only be agreeable for maintenance of the new structure to be placed on the bridge and not existing components of the bridge.

It is considered that this item could be negotiated under the licence to limit maintenance responsibility to the new walkway structure to be placed on the bridge

## 2. Approval for works on Rail Bridge-Contractor for Transport NSW

In considering the approval for works on the bridge John Holland Rail expressed concern over safety issues with deteriorating sleepers on the bridge and as a condition they were intending to remove the rail and sleepers. This intention was included in an application under Section 60 to Heritage Council of NSW by John Holland Rail and approval was refused on the grounds that rail and sleepers should remain.

It is considered that the compromise involving removal of sleepers but retaining rail can be negotiated with assistance of relevant Minister and our local member

### Access to the Bridge structure

It is likely that UGL will remove the viaduct due to its poor condition and public safety risks and this aspect has already been subject to a public consultation.

There is therefore scope for access to be bridge structure within the rail corridor with no conflict to adjoining land use.

Narrandera Landcare Inc has invested many years and funding to develop this Lattice Rail bridge concept with considerable support of Council staff. Narrandera Landcare urges Council to reflect community views and aspirations and reallocate funding from the proposed Skywalk project to this significant tourism and community benefit project.

Thank you for the opportunity for us to provide a submission with regards to the proposed Skywalk Project at Lake Talbot, Narrandera.

We strongly object to this Eyesore spoiling the natural beauty of the Lake Talbot escarpment and will vigorously fight Council in any move to advance the project.

The actions of the previous Council in relation to the rejection of the Lattice Bridge Project at the 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021 Meeting (Item 15.1) for no significant reason and the quick swap to a Skywalk Project at the 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2021 Meeting (Item 17.1) does not meet acceptable community expectations. In fact, Community Members who understand the full facts of the matter think the actions of the previous Council are unethical and reinforce the low standing Narrandera Shire Council Leadership has in our Community. There are many unanswered questions.

In relation to the rejection of the Lattice Bridge Project, four reasons for the refusal were given at the October Council Meeting. These reasons have been repeated on Community Radio (21/3/2022) and in the Narrandera Argus (24/3/2022). We want to list each of these pitiful reasons and add commentary:-

- Loss of Amenity for adjoining properties: We requested all submissions in relation to the Lattice Bridge Project. We expected several submissions but to our astonishment there were only 2 submissions. The 2 Submissions which we examined were not strong and we ask the following questions:
  - (A) Are these two landowners so influential that they can knock out this outstanding Project?
  - (B) Did the landowners not know when they purchased that they live next to an existing Rail Corridor and close to the junction of 2 National Highways?

- (C) How are these landowners going to cope if the Narrandera to Tocumwal Rail Project gets built?
- (D) Would the completion of the proposed 24 Hour Service Station at Gillenbah cause greater loss of amenity?
- (E) The Mayor has a best friend who is a landowner in the vicinity of the Lattice Bridge Project. Has the Mayor declared a Conflict Of Interest (Non-Pecuniary) in relation to his voting in the matter?
- 2. Potential Increase in Operational Costs: We ask the following questions:
  - (A) Have these costs been Quantified?
  - (B) Has the Narrandera Shire Council Audit Risk and Improvement Committee been consulted on these Risks? The current Chairperson of that Committee is a very experienced Local Government Manager who has risk assessed and brought many projects to fruition.
  - (C) Have the Operational Costs of the Skywalk been quantified?
- 3. No tenure over the surrounding land and access to the bridge as it currently sits on Crown Land: We ask the following questions:
  - (A) So what? There are many examples in rural and metropolitan NSW where Council Projects sit on Crown Land.
  - (B) Has Council had any meetings with NSW Crown Lands to overcome any obstacles which we would consider minor?
- 4. The attraction of visitors to that area may have impacted the Aboriginal Heritage. We ask the following questions:
  - (A) What consultation has Council carried out with our Aboriginal Community? There seems to be support in our Aboriginal Community for the Lattice Bridge project.
  - (B) Is Council using our Aboriginal Community and Heritage to defend their appalling lack of judgement?

There are several other unanswered questions that we would also like to ask the Mayor:-

- 1. Why has Council waited 4 Months for Community Consultation to commence regards the Skywalk? It was voted on at the Council Meeting of 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2021 and only open for Submissions from mid March 2022?
- 2. Why did 5 Councilors vote against the Executive Notice OF Motion on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021 supporting the Lattice Bridge Project when there were only minor obstacles?
- 3. Does Council think it ethical to swap the well researched Lattice Bridge Project for the quick Skywalk idea?

- 4. Why did Council push through the Skywalk project within a fortnight of the Local Government Election of 4<sup>th</sup> December 2021?
- 5. Council was advised of a Community Meeting on 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2022. The Meeting was well attended by the Community on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2022 at the Narrandera Exservicemen's Club. Why did the Council not advertise the meeting on Social Media as with all other happenings in the Shire?
- 6. What due Diligence, such as an EIS, has been completed in relation to the Skywalk Project to date?
- 7. How much Ratepayers Money in staff time has been spent on the rejected Lattice Bridge Project?
- 8. How much Ratepayers Money in staff time has been spent so far on the Skywalk Project?
- 9. Why does the Mayor allow the General Manager and the Deputy General Manager Infrastructure to monopolise and lead the Community Debate regards the rejection of the Lattice Bridge Project and the quick swap to a Lake Talbot Lookout?
- 10. Does Council believe it has acted ethically and in the community interest by ditching a 5 year volunteer project for the weakest of reasons?

It is now April 2022 and Narrandera Shire Council has a new set of Councillors. Please reject the Skywalk Project and reinstate the Lattice Bridge Project. The minor obstacles regarding the Lattice Bridge Project can be overcome with enthusiasm and focus. It will be the first step in restoring accountability and integrity at Narrandera Shire Council.



Thank you for the opportunity to provide this submission.

I am asking Council to stop the Skywalk project immediately.

I am responding after hearing from both the Community and Council.

I believe the Skywalk is an ill-conceived project that has not been well researched, will not serve as a "real" tourist destination, does not fit with the beauty and amenity of Lake Talbot, is uninspired in design and will be a permanent, ugly scar on the lake.

It will be an unloved permanent reminder of how our Council can get a project so wrong and waste money. If built, it will have been completed without proper Community consultation, support or due diligence. The Skywalk project demonstrates how out of touch Council is with the Community it represents.

The Skywalk project appears to be just a "quick" fallback project with Council's motivation to just spend the Rail Bridge grant on the basis the council was unable to deliver the Rail Bridge project. The true reasons behind Councils failure to deliver the Rail Bridge project after years of work and at considerable cost, then rejecting their own approved DA has still not been fully explained.

Council have not confirmed, to date, they have undertaken "full" due diligence on the Skywalk project. As an example, has an environmental impact statement been done and if so, has it been made public. There appears to be no visitation data on who will visit the Skywalk. Council representatives at the Town Meeting agreed with a question from the floor, it would be minimal, confined to caravan park users and pool visitors and few others.

Council has not consulted with the community and has, to date, not been unable to provide what level of community support there is for the Skywalk.

I am also asking Council to turn their attention back to the Rail Bridge project and for Council to seek approval to return the funding back to the original and rightful Rail Bridge Project. Council has been very clear and strong stating at the Town Meeting the Rail Bridge project has not been abandoned, therefore it should now recommence from where Council left off.



access to Koori beach on the Murrumbidgee.



Proposal 3; - Erect a proper Air/Sky Bridge at the southern side at the Rocky Waterholes Bridge off the canal bank with a 1 Metre wide ramp with 1.2 M high fence rising to 12 metres height, a flat bridge on steel A stilts with anti-swing cables, then a ramp down to the Forest floor. Thus providing a Bridge over the billabong in wet times to the interior of the Reserve, with the opportunity to be near Treetops for better Koala viewing. This would be a real Skywalk.



Proposal 4 – Erect a high Bridge at the southern side at the Regulator Reserve entrance gate 7 metres high to cross the low flood area. The distance is approximately 200 metres. It would be easier to hammer rust treated steel into the ground & run a single RSJ steel beam between supports & trees using knurled plate steel for the path with 1.2 m fencing. This would be however a high maintenance feature.



Proposal 4 - Return the balance of the \$820,000 funds to Consolidated revenue requesting it be redirected to Flood housing relief in Northern NSW.

Please note; It has been suggested that the young people like the idea of a Sky walk. Of course they would, without the full knowledge! When explained to them they are almost all keen to have the Rail bridge safety upgraded to view the River and its currents.


